ICAR- CSWRI:-

The ICAR- Central Sheep and Wool Research Institute is a premier Institute of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) engaged in research and extension activities primarily on sheep. It was established in 1962 at Malpura in Rajasthan. The campus is spread over an area of 1591.20 hectare. Institute has three Regional Research Centres in different climatic zones of the country to develop region specific technologies. North Temperate Regional Station (NTRS) was established in 1963 in temperate region at Garsa, Kullu in Himachal Pradesh. The Southern Regional Research Centre (SRRC) was established in 1965 in sub temperate region at Mannavanur in Tamil Nadu. Arid Region Campus (ARC) was established in 1974 at Bikanaer in arid region of Rajsthan. Mandate of Institute are basic and applied research on sheep production, health, utilization, training and transfer of technologies to the beneficiaries. Apart from research, Institute supply superior germplasm of Malpura, Marwari, Magra, Chokla breed of sheep, impart training to farmers, veterinary surgeons, organize Kisan Mela, participate in activities carried out by other institutes etc. The institute has different divisions like Animal Genetics and Breeding, Animal Physiology and Biochemistry, Animal Health, Animal Nutrition, Textile Manufacturing and Textile Chemistry and Transfer of Technology.

Facilities available:

Institute rear more than 3000 sheep, 700 goats for research and demonstration purpose. Institute have dedicated subject matter specialist in different divisions who impart training to farmers, veterinary surgeons and professionals. Institute have a farmer hostel which can accommodate 50 farmers.



Location:

The Institute is situated in Malpura thesil of Tonk district of Rajasthan State on Jaipur-Bhilwara state highway no- 12 approx. 85 away from Jaipur.

Climate:

Avikanagar comes under semi-arid climatic region. The average annual rainfall is about 613 mm. South West monsoon normally begins in the last week of June and continues up to September. The average temperature of different seasons is as under:-
