
Sub: Revised evaluation criteria for selection of the candidates for improving the objectivity in the selection process for selection of the candidate(s) on purely contract basis to work against the temporary positions of SFR / JRF / YP-I / YP-II for a fixed tenure – regd.

On the subject cited above it is to inform that for improving the objectivity in the selection process for selecting the candidates on purely contract basis to work against the temporary positions of SRF / JRF / YP-I / YP-II for a fixed tenure, the Competent Authority has been pleased to approve the revised evaluation criteria (vide Annexure – I to Annexure – VI) to be adopted for recruitment of SRFs / JRFs / YPs for improving objectivity in selection of SRFs / JRFs / YPs in the institute and / or external funded project. The said revised evaluation criteria will be followed with immediate effect-

Further, now onwards the following procedure will be followed for recruiting the SRFs / JRFs / YPs in the institute and / or external funded project:

1. After receiving the requisitions from the PIs / Scientists / Officers, the concerned will be asked to provide the details about the minimum educational qualification & research experience in the relevant field in respect of position for which the requisition has been given. The minimum educational qualification & research experience in the relevant field will be in accordance to the general guidelines as mentioned in the Annexure- I to Annexure-VI. Accordingly, the advertisement will be finalized in consultation with the concerning PI / Scientist / Officer and with the approval of the Competent Authority.
2. The advertisement & other guidelines will then be uploaded on Institute's website & also will be published in local newspaper for wide publicity. **The selection will be made through walk in interview.**
3. The screening of the documents related to educational and desirable qualification of the candidate(s) will take place, before commencement of walk in interview of the candidate, to verify the marks claimed by the candidate(s) on these accounts.
4. The walk in interview will be conducted by a selection committee of three or five members which will be constituted by the Director, ICAR-CSWRI. After completion of interview, the proceeding of the selection committee with the list of selected and reserve list of candidate(s) may be put up before the Competent Authority for approval & further necessary action.
5. Once the selection process is complete, all the relevant information related to the process will be disclosed suo-moto as per the provision of RTI Act-2005 by uploading the same on Institute's website for information to all the concerned.
