About the Conference

About the venue

It is engaged in conducting basic and applied research in the areas of sheep breeding, nutrition, physiology, reproduction, health, biotechnology, utilization of different sheep products, providing training and transfer of technologies to the beneficiaries from last more than half a century. The Institute headquarter is located at Avikanagar near Malpura, Distt. Tonk, Rajasthan on Jaipur-Bhilwara State Highway (Diggi Malpura Road). It has three regional stations, namely, Arid Region Campus (ARC), Bikaner, Rajasthan; Northern Temperate Research Station (NTRS), Garsa, Kullu, Himachal Pradesh and Southern Regional Research Centre (SRRC), Mannavanur, Tamil Nadu.

Avikanagar is about 90 km from Jaipur and well connected by Rajasthan Roadways buses which are frequently available from Sindhi camp bus stand (2 km away from Jaipur Railway junction). The weather at Avikanagar during February is pleasant in daytime (15-20°C). The Division of Animal Physiology and Biochemistry, ICAR-CSWRI, Avikanagar was started as Physiology section in the year 1965. Later, in the year 1975 the section was upgraded to the division to carry out both basic and applied research in the area of adaptive and reproductive physiology and biochemistry in sheep. Over the last five decades the division has emerged as one of the leading research centres on sheep in India. The division is well equipped with advanced research facilities has well qualified and trained scientific and technical staffs. Therefore, the participants will have a good exposure to the various aspects of sheep physiology and allied research activities in the campus.
